Collaborative Network Approach (CNA) - Applications with Individuals Experiencing Early Psychosis and other Psychiatric Crises

CNA, developed in Vermont, brings elements of Open Dialogue and related ways of working that invite connection and meaning through dialogic practice.

This program is designed and presented by practitioners from Vermont and elsewhere who have been deeply immersed in this work and are excited to share their experiences. This meeting is intended to help us as we expand the training to include other agencies.

Participants will have the opportunity to:

- Learn about the evolution CNA, the training program, and implementation projects in Vermont and elsewhere
- Understand the distinction between CNA and other programs developed for early episode psychosis
- Hear from those who are doing this work: how they got started and their particular journeys of adapting these practices in various settings
- Talk with those who have participated in the last two years of statewide CNA training
- Learn about utilizing CNA principles in inpatient and outpatient settings including discussion of how CNA can enhance inpatient-outpatient collaboration and continuity of care as well as influence on workplace morale and turnover

Through a combination of presentations and work-shops, each organization will be able to consider potential implementation within their own program.

Audience: Anyone who wants to explore the benefits and challenges of systematically spreading this practice to interested in adopting it in their own settings throughout Vermont.

The 4TH Annual Gathering of Programs Working With Dialogic Network Practices

Friday, June 15th and Saturday June 16th

Vermont is pleased to be hosting this year's meeting of programs working on applications of practices informed by open dialogue, reflecting process, and needs adapted approaches. This forum is modeled after meetings that have been occurring over the past 20 years in northern Europe. The agenda is created collaboratively in real time.

Discussions in the past have included:

- Clinical consultations
- Experiences with applying these practices within varied existing service systems (inpatient and outpatient),
- Discussions addressing coercive practices,
- Research
- Discussions of how we carry different professional roles in these practices

Many discussions have also included opportunities to practice interviewing and reflecting process together in both small and large groups.

This meeting is open to people with any level of familiarity with dialogic network practices. There will be an introduction to reflecting process for anyone who is interested. We encourage all participants to come with their ideas about how best to use the time together.
